

What do the chimpanzees do all day?

Pick a chimpanzee to observe.

Using your stopwatch, observe the chimpanzee you chose for 10 seconds. While observing the chimpanzee you chose, watch for the following behaviors:

- Playing
- Eating/drinking – putting food in its mouth
- Resting – sitting or laying down
- Moving – walking, running, or climbing
- Aggressiveness – fighting with or hitting other chimpanzees, yelling at other chimpanzees
- Grooming – picking at its own hair or the hair of another, scratching its body or the body of another, putting its hand gently on another chimp
- Other

After observing the chimpanzee for 10 seconds, choose the behavior that occurred the most during the time you observed. You should do this 4 times and put an “x” in the box below next to the behavior you saw each time.
